Administrative Matters

Bruce called the meeting to order at 7:07 pm. The EAB approved the April 7th minutes by unanimous vote.

Draft FLX Text Amendment

The EAB reviewed and adopted a recommendation for a proposed ordinance text amendment for a new FLX district. The EAB concluded in principle that the draft amendment is acceptable, and also included in the recommendation language to request that the EAB and public be allowed the the same level of review as currently happens with other development projects. The recommendation included a request that the EAB get detailed enough plans that the EAB can perform its duties and perform a comprehensive and detailed environmental review and provide recommendations to the Board of Aldermen, and obtain more clarity on when in the process sufficient detail will be made available to perform this review.

Jordan Lake Water Quality and Rules Presentation

Randy provided a presentation with an overview of Jordan Lake water quality, with a focus on the history and status of the State and local regulatory process. The first part of the presentation went into, at a state level, the history of the lake, lake uses, water quality specifically as associated with eutrophication, the nutrient strategy mandates and status, and the solar bee demonstration project. The second part of the presentation went into what Carrboro has done/is doing with regards to fertilizer management, stream buffers, and stormwater management for both new and existing development.
