











How do we get there?

- More detailed assessment of the watershed
 - Locate problem areas
 - Identify potential solutions
- Find funding (and leverage resources)
 - 319 program
 - CWMTF
 - EEP
- Implement Solutions

Next Step – Stormwater Minigrant

- Geomorphic analysis of stream segments
- Identification of problem areas and severity
- Identification of potential sources
- Identification of potential BMPs, their costs, and conditions favorable to or limiting their implementation

Ongoing Implementation

- Long-term effort
- Opportunities for your future involvement

Ongoing and Future Steps

- Promote buy in from community-at-large
- Landowner collaboration
- Toxicity source identification and reduction
- Stream channel stabilization and restoration
- Riparian vegetation maintenance
- Stormwater education and outreach
- Other?
